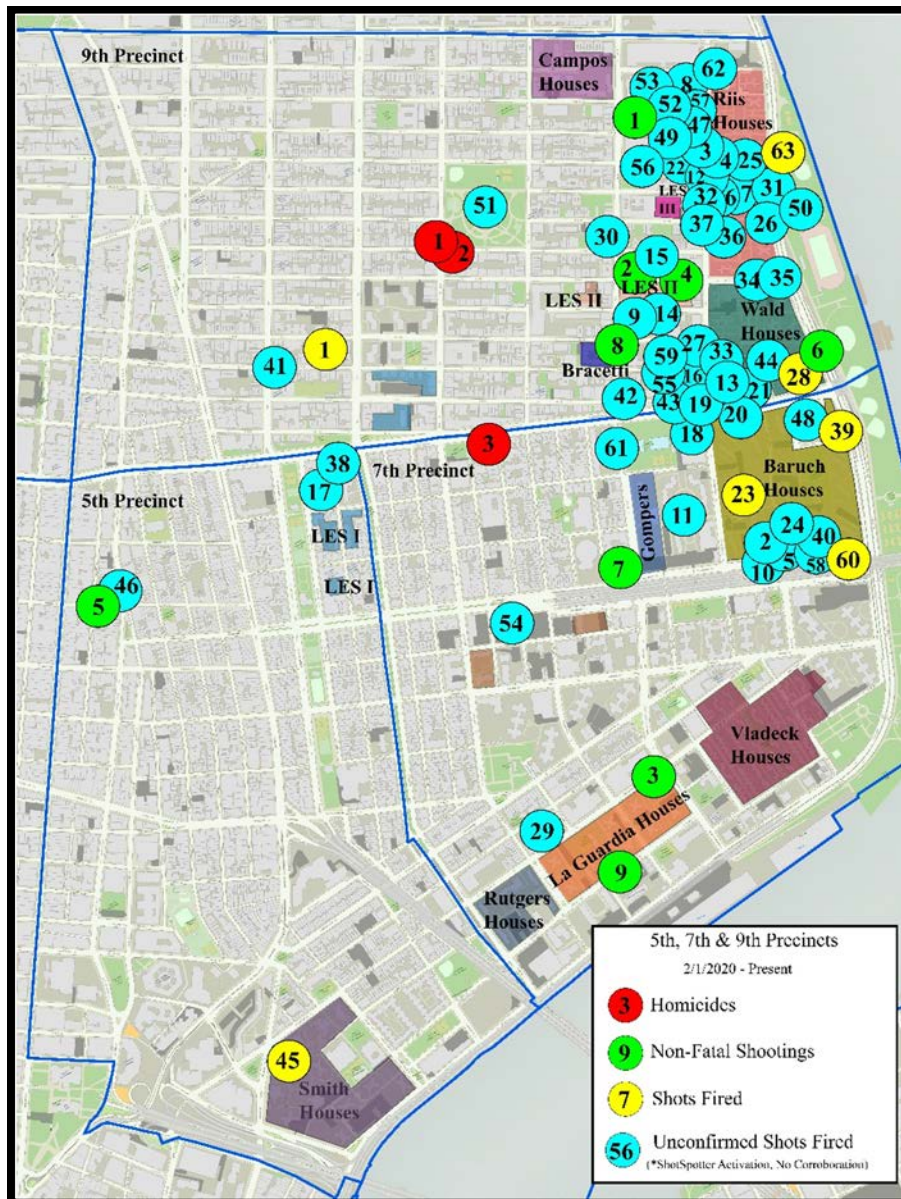

## Homicides

1. **1/9/2020**- At about 0336 hours, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were shooting at each other in front of East 7th Street and Avenue A. [REDACTED] was struck in the torso and removed to Bellevue Hospital where he was pronounced DOA at 0407 hours. Police officers observed the gunfire exchange and shot at [REDACTED] who was also removed to Bellevue Hospital and pronounced DOA at 0401 hours. Two firearms were recovered at the scene. ADA [REDACTED] (TB60). **9th Precinct.**
2. **4/8/2020** - At about 2215 hours, [REDACTED] (64 y/o) and [REDACTED] were involved in a verbal dispute inside of Wine Heaven, located, at 333 3rd Avenue. [REDACTED] then stabbed [REDACTED] approximately five times in the chest, stuffed a ring down her throat and fled the location. [REDACTED] was transported to Bellevue Hospital where she was pronounced DOA. See [REDACTED] NY. ADA [REDACTED] (TB50). **13th Precinct.**

## Non-Fatal Shootings

1. **1/16/2020** - At about 1528 hours, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were involved in an argument in front of 178 Avenue C. [REDACTED] pulled out a firearm and fired one shot into the ground and fired a second shot, which struck [REDACTED] in the abdomen. The first shot ricocheted and grazed [REDACTED] (44 y/o) in the back of her left thigh. [REDACTED] fled. See [REDACTED] NY. ADA [REDACTED] (TB80). **9th Precinct.**
2. **3/8/2020** - At about 0500 hours, [REDACTED] pointed a gun at [REDACTED] chest inside of 716 East 6th Street (**LES II**). When [REDACTED] pushed [REDACTED] arm away, [REDACTED] pulled the trigger. The bullet struck [REDACTED] in the leg and shattering is leg bone, which required surgery. One live round was found in front of 724 East 6th Street and one shell casing was recovered from the 3rd floor hallway of 716 East 6th Street. See [REDACTED] NY. ADA [REDACTED] (TB60). **9th Precinct.**

## Shots Fired

1. **1/1/2020** - At about 0345 hours, Police Officers responded to a report of shots fired in front of 120 East 4th Street. As they approached they heard 3-5 additional shots fired. Police

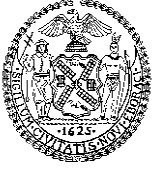

officers observed three men fleeing the scene that were taken into custody. As the men were being arrested, [REDACTED] was walking eastbound on 4th Street, very irate about the three men being taken into custody. An officer arrested [REDACTED] for acting disorderly. While inside of the patrol car, [REDACTED] slammed his head causing laceration and swelling to his right eye. Fifteen .45 rounds total were recovered. One bullet fragment, three live rounds and eleven shell casings. One .45 round of ammunition was recovered from [REDACTED] pocket that matched the shell casing and live rounds recovered from the scene. See [REDACTED] ADA [REDACTED] (TB70). **9<sup>th</sup> Precinct.**

2. **1/10/2020-** At about 1501 hours, ShotSpotter was activated in front of 288 Delancey Street (**Baruch Houses**). No ballistic evidence was recovered. **7<sup>th</sup> Precinct.**
3. **1/10/2020-** At about 2305 hours, ShotSpotter was activated for five rounds at street level in front of 152 Avenue D (**Riis Houses**). No ballistic evidence was recovered. **9<sup>th</sup> Precinct.**
