



Vic1 asked Susp to show his ID to purchase the cigarettes. Susp pulled out a knife and demanded that Vic1 open the register. Vic1 ran and screamed for help while Susp took cigarettes and the cash drawer and fled the scene. Invest ongoing.



Susp told Vic2 he wasn't feeling well and began looking for medicine. Vic2 told Susp to get a cup of coffee. Susp grabbed a coffee, began drinking it and walked to a chair by the cashier counter. Susp got up from the chair and brandished a long knife w/ a blk handle. Susp put the knife against Vic2's side and stated, "give me the money". Vic2 told Susp to sit down and he would give him the money. Susp went through the cash register and took \$100 and fled.


On 1/9/20 and 1/17/20 there were commercial robberies in the 4th district involving 2 male suspects. In both incidents, one suspect was wearing white gloves. Please see the details below and the attached reports!

- Date: 1/17/2020
- Time: 4:50 PM
- District: 4
- Location: 2966 E 116th St (Dollar General)
- Narrative: Vic2 (Virginia Cowart 3/21/96) stated Susp1 (B/M, bik Adidas pants, blue champion hoodie, face completely covered, no gloves on, carrying a bik drawstring backpack) and Susp2 (B/M, navy blue Nike pants, bik Nautica hoodie, yellow/bik mask w/ upper face showing, bik/yellow lordin shoes, white gloves on) entered the store with bik gues, demanding money. Susp1 pointed a gun at Vic2 and demanded the money out of the drawer while Susp2 stood at the front door as a lookout. Susps then exited the store and field. Susps threw out the money tracker on E117th S1 & Buckeye.
- Suspects: 2 Black Males
- Follow Up: Det. spoke with Virginia Cowart on 1/18/10 who stated the lookout suspect was wearing a red bandana and white gloves and the gunman was wearing a black mask and was not wearing gloves.

- Namathe: Vic2 (Renea Saffo 3/15/82) stated Susp1 (M, wearing all bik, white gloves) and Susp2 (M, white/bik hooded flannel, drk pants, light colored shoes, small silver gun)
 entered the loc through the back door. Susp2 ordered Vic2 to the back office and forced her to open the safe and give him all the money. Susps then fied out of the back door.
 RP (Tyrone Coleman 1/11/70) stated he just fired a female (Kiresten Brown) for stealing and she recently fell on hard times. The female made statements about having her BF
 (Charles Black) rob the place.
- Suspects: 2 Males
- Follow Up: Det. spoke with the district manager who stated he does not know who the offender is, but will provide a copy of video when the corporate manager comes in. The
 district manager does not have any reason to believe Charles Bial had anything to do with the robbery.
